

**FROM NORTH ARKANSAS.**—Our information from the Northern part of the State, is to the effect that about fifteen hundred of the enemy are advancing as if to come down on the western side of Black river. Another force not by any means as large as has been represented by our home sensation-mongers, is reported as having entered the State at Chalk Bluff, the head of Crowley's Ridge.— There is nothing to induce the belief that a serious invasion of the State is intended. Most probably the move is to procure forage, which is doubtless, exhausted in South-east Missouri; or, it may be a raid for the purpose of distroying crops and other property.

Since writing the above a gentleman has arrived direct from Pocahontas, who says that, when he left, there was no news of any Federal force moveing in that direction; and an officer from Crowley's Ridge reports that the Federal force in that region has been greatly overrated—that it amounted to but a few hundred men.
