

## LODGE WILL NOT BUILD HOSPITAL

Odd Fellows Will Not Secure Sufficient Amount From Shirey Estate, It Is Announced

The will of the late A. W. Shirey of Minturn, who left all of his property to the Odd Fellows lodge of Arkansas, will not be followed out in the matter of building a sanitarium at Hot Springs and an orphans' and widows' home in Lawrence county. Grand Master Louis Josephs of Newport was in lattle Nova yesteristy and stated that the activement of the Shirey estate would not leave sufficient runds to carry out those provisions of the will. That portion of the estate which goes to the Odd Fellows will be increed into the general treasury of the lodge. It is not known now for what purpose the money will be used.

I neer the terms of the settlement the lodge will get 40 per cent of the estate, the widow 40 per cent, and the remainder of the heirs 20 per cent. Mr. Josephs stated yesterday that the value of the estate had been overestimated and declared that he does not believe at will prove to be worth more than \$550.00.

Appraisers willy be appointed the wiek to estimate the value of the estimate.

Grand Master Josephs will go to Pine Bluff today to attend a meeting of the lorge there, at which 1:0 candidates are to be initiated. From there he will go to Walnut Rolge to attend to business connected with the dission of the extate.
